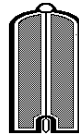
were entertained by the "Egyptian Unit, who performed two Oriental dances. One of which they were dressed in shiny gold outfits. It was very good.

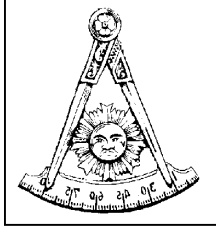
