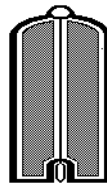
May is Grand Lodge Month, which means one of our meetings will be used for proposed changes to the Ma-

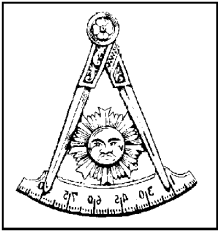
