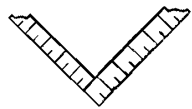

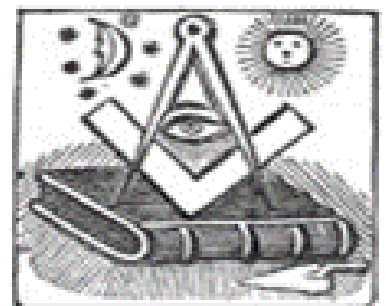

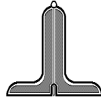

Masonic Education makeup classes will be scheduled during the month for those who wish to make up the past sections that were missed.

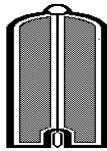

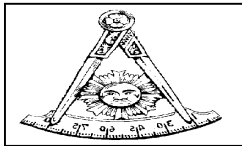
