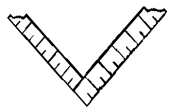

Nitram Lodge is progressing in passing to Fellow Craft four Brothers and initiating 2 Entered Apprentices. We hope to have

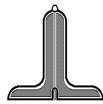
some raised to Master Mason before Christmas.

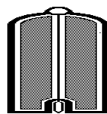
Your time could also be used to renew old friendships that have fallen by the wayside over the years. You might be surprised at how much enjoyment YOU will get out of it.

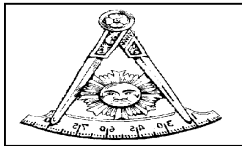
