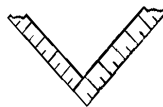

Our stated meetings are on the 2nd and

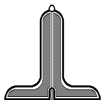

have a budget too. Our Lodge must stay within the guidelines of our budget.

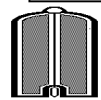

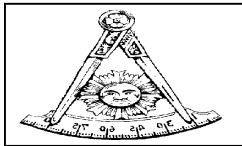
