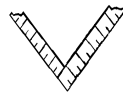

Master's Message

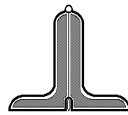
Brothers,

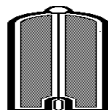
Senior Warden's Writings

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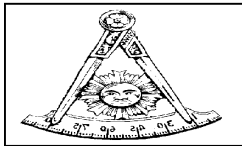

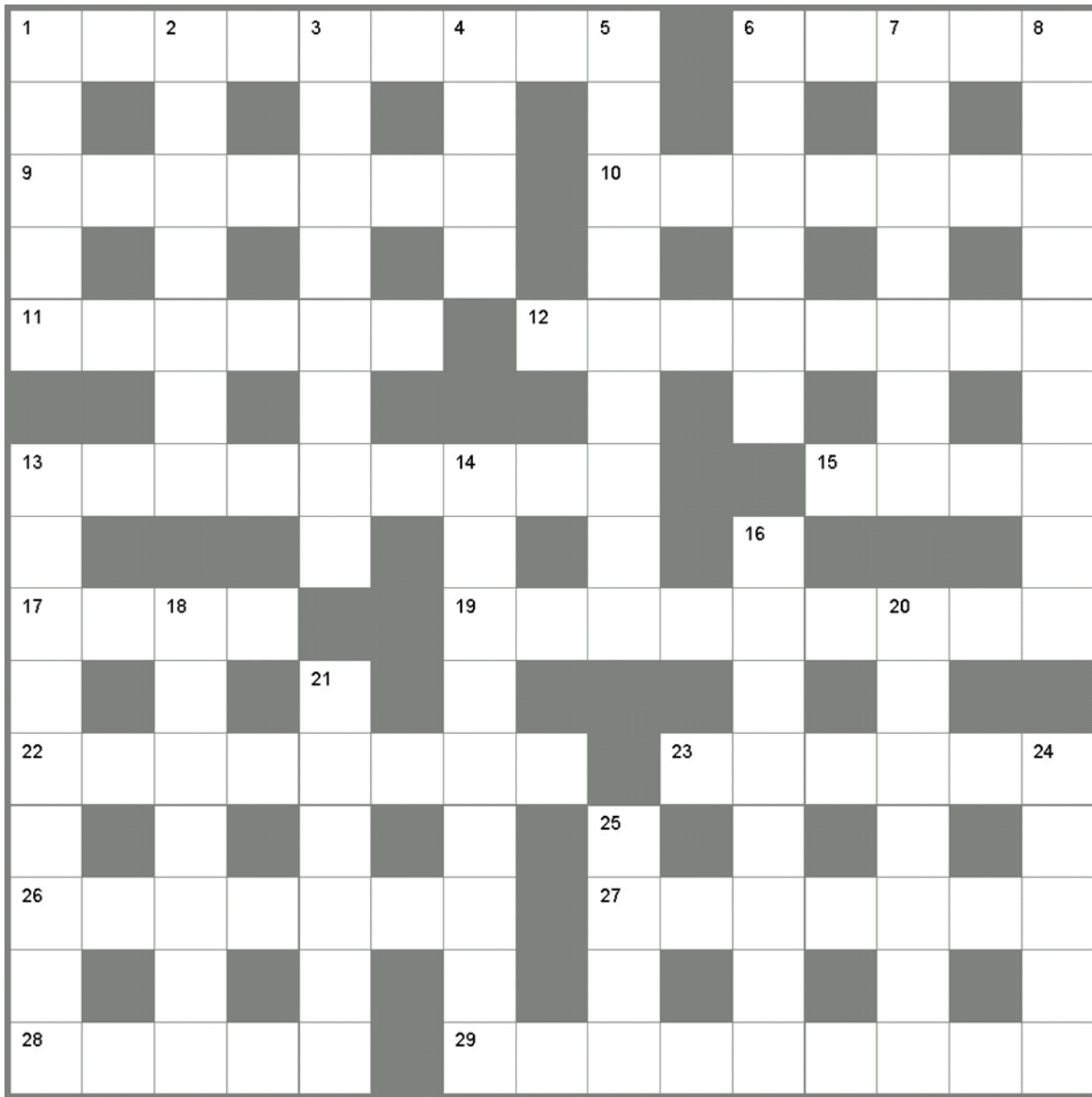
